- We learn about rights in our school, to help you understand this we have included a Pocket Book of Rights in your information pack. The pocketbook explains all the promises made to children by the UK government when they signed up to the UNCRC.
- We are also a Nurture school, this means our school environment supports our wellbeing in being the best we can be.
- As an adult you are a DUTYBEARER. That means you must help the RIGHTS
 HOLDERS (your child(ren) get access to their rights.
- Every classroom has a Classroom Charter and the 6 principles of Nurture
 displayed that all the pupils and staff in the school have agreed to and know about.
- Our school is a community, we all care about and look out for each other.
- It is very important that everybody communicates to each
 other in a Rights Respecting way. This means explaining
 things carefully, having good manners, not raising our voices and
 disagreeing respectfully with each other.
- We care about our wellbeing and use Zones of Regulation and
 Wellbeing rooms to help us regulate ourselves throughout the day.
